## Introduction

This is the seventh edition of the Profiles of ASA members since it was first published in 1998. As for previous editions, the listing was open to all ASA members, regardless of nationality, place of business, experience in international arbitration or familiarity with Swiss law.

For the preparation of this edition, ASA has revised its website, substantially improving in particular the presentation of each profile and the search functions. ASA is confident that this has greatly increased the usefulness of the Profiles as a tool for arbitration practitioners all over the world.

As the online profiles on the ASA website can be updated at any time, they are likely to become in due course the preferred tool for the presentation of ASA members. Nevertheless, there was a strong demand among ASA members to preserve the printed version of the Profiles in their original paper format, beside the electronic format on the ASA website. ASA therefore decided to continue offering both the electronic version and the printed book, but allowed each member to choose whether to subscribe to one or the other or both. As it turned out, the vast majority of the subscribers renewed their subscription to both.

The data in each of the profiles was collected on the basis of a uniform electronic questionnaire completed by the subscribers. As is inevitable with such an exercise not all categories could fit exactly the information provided and some constraint resulted from the space available in particular for publications.

As to the content of the data, ASA has relied on each member providing information that is "true and fair" without verifying its accuracy. Entry into the volume may not be taken as a recommendation by ASA.

ASA hopes that this new edition of the Profiles of ASA Members is as useful as its predecessors, to its members and to the international arbitration community.

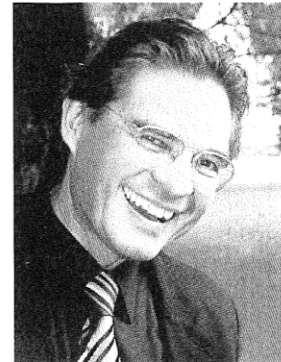
